We are a feminist, women led charity working to end rape and sexual violence by supporting and empowering survivors across Darlington and County Durham. If you need to talk to someone in confidence about sexual abuse, we are here for you.



We offer men and boys a range of services to support you and also can signpost you to other organisations that can help male sexual violence survivors.



Supporting male sexual violence survivors

Men and boys experience, are affected by and are at risk of rape and sexual violence. We offer a range of support to male survivors through a number of our services. Men and boys can access our counselling, our Independent Sexual Violence Advisor (ISVA) service, our Emotional Support Line and our Emotional Support Email.

Counselling

Men and boys can access our specialist counselling at any time after the abuse has occurred. It is available at a variety of locations across Darlington and County Durham.

ISVA Service

Our ISVA service offers non-judgemental, practical and emotional support to survivors of sexual abuse who are thinking of reporting to the police or who have reported to the police.

Emotional Support Line

We have a telephone support line where male survivors can call for support and one of our highly trained team will be there to listen empathetically and without judgement.
